The center now features a well-equipped lodge, beautiful log home, gazebo, zip line, amphitheater, creek side trails, spacious lawns, and an inspiring master site plan.

Thousands of people, including groups of all ages, have been touched by God at this site. Feedback includes phrases such as, "we love it here," "what an amazing setting in the heart of God's creation," and "love and grace abound here."

The center began in 1989 with Founding Board Members Alan and Anna Waltar, Steve and Sandra Critchlow, Lane and Gwen Bray, and Roger and Carol Johnson.

The Legacy Endowment Fund, established in 2015, is managed by the Community Foundation of North Central Washington. The CFNCW has a well-established record, now managing over 74 million dollars in assets for charitable organizations, and growing.
